



ERASMUS + STUDY MOBILITY FOR STUDENTS

Students may participate in the Erasmus+ Mobility Program for studying abroad several times, totalling up to 12 months maximum per each cycle of study (undergraduate/master/doctoral).

Within the Erasmus+ Key Action 1 – Mobility of Individuals, opportunities are provided for students to undertake a study period abroad at a partner higher education institution (HEI).

Within the KA103 project, the receiving organisation must be a Program Country Higher Education Institution awarded with an Erasmus Charter for Higher Education having signed an inter-institutional agreement with UNP before the mobility takes place.

Within the KA107 project, the receiving organisation must be a Higher Education Institution from the Partner Country stipulated within the project.

The study period abroad must be part of the student's study program to complete a degree at UNP at first or second cycle (undergraduate or equivalent/Master or equivalent) cycle.

The mobility activities are expected to produce the following outcomes:

- improved learning performance;
- enhanced employability and improved career prospects;
- increased sense of initiative and entrepreneurship;
- increased self-empowerment and self-esteem;
- improved foreign language competences;
- enhanced intercultural awareness;
- more active participation in society;
- better awareness of the European project and the EU values;
- increased motivation for taking part in future (formal/non-formal) education or training after the mobility period abroad.
